


A Pilgrimage to Spain

Following the Path of Pilgrims of Old On the Road to Santiago de Compostela

October 27 – November 6, 2019



The Camino de Santiago, or the way of St. James, has many different routes, all uniting as one at the Cathedral in Santiago de Compostela in Galicia, Spain. This same path has been taken for hundreds of years by the faithful making their holy pilgrimage to Santiago de Compostela. Roman, Moor, and Saracen invaders, the Knights Templar, and the armies of Charlemagne and Napoleon have also used the path. Therefore, this journey is not only steeped in spiritual significance as you travel to the place believed to be the burial site of St. James, but it also has much historical and cultural significance.

This pilgrimage involves physical activity, including the ability to walk many miles at a time, to climb stairs, to climb hills and mountains and to be “on one’s feet” for hours at a time. The terrain is varied, ranging from simple footpaths to paved highways. Some of the footpaths are gravel, rocky, dusty, muddy and rutted by farmer’s tractors. Pilgrims will need sturdy hiking boots and collapsible poles.

Day 1, Sunday, October 27, 2019 – We depart **Denver, CO** on our **American Airlines** flight into **Chicago O’Hare** where we change planes and connect to our trans-Atlantic flight on **Iberia Airlines** into **Madrid, Spain**. **M**

Day 2, Mon. – Upon arrival in **Madrid**, we meet our driver and guide, and we board our coach. We visit **Prado** and **Reina Sofia Art Galleries** to acquaint ourselves with Spanish history and culture by some of Spain’s greatest artists. Our journey continues to **Segovia**, an important stop along the Sephardic Way and where we will walk from the **Roman Aqueduct** to the **Discalced Carmelite Friary** to see the **Tomb of St. John of the Cross** before continuing on to **Avila** for dinner and overnight. **D**

Day 3, Tues. – This morning, we enjoy a walk around the **Walls of Avila** to the **Convent of the Encarnacion**, where Santa Teresa of Avila lived for many years, and where she experienced many of her encounters with Jesus. We continue on to **Leon** located on the **Bernesga River** in northwest Spain. We visit the **Cathedral** with its magnificent stain glass windows. Dinner and overnight **Leon**. **BD**

Day 4, Wed. – Our journey continues today as we travel to the **Pilgrims Way**. We stop in **Astorga** to pick up any provisions needed for our walking days before continuing on to **Foncebaddon**. We walk the short distance to the emblematic pilgrim site of **Cruz de Ferro** in the **Bierzo Mountains** where we have some reflection time. Then on to the hilltop town of **O Cebreiro**, a village nestled in the **Ancares Mountains**, before arriving in **Sarria** for dinner and overnight. **BLD**





Day 5, Thurs. –Sarria to Portomarin 23km. Today, we hike through the beautiful rolling hills of **Galicia** to **Portomarin**. Dinner and overnight **Portomarin**. **BD**

Day 6, Fri. – Portomarin to Palas de Rei 25km. We leave the **River Miño** behind as we climb the hill out of **Portomarin**. Our walk taking us towards **Gonzar, Hospital da Cruz** and **Ligonde**, and finally to **Palas de Rei**. Dinner and overnight **Palas de Rei**. **BD**

Day 7, Sat. – Palas de Rei to Ribadiso 27km. Today is our longest day of walking. We travel through forests and along streams. **Melide**, one of the main towns that we pass today, is the half way point. Dinner and overnight **Ribadiso**. **BD**

Day 8, Sun. – Ribadiso to Arca (Perdouzo) 23km. After the storm comes the calm. We enjoy a much shorter day today as we near **Santiago**. It is a perfect day to reflect on the past days, and to go at a snail's pace. Dinner and overnight **Arca (Pedrouzo)**. **BD**

Day 9, Mon. – Pedrouzo to Santiago de Compostela 20km. Our final day of walking, we say goodbye to the countryside and begin passing the busier villages, as we get closer to **Santiago**. We will regroup at **Monte do Gozo** (Mount of Joy) to walk the last 4 km of this journey together into the city of **Santiago de Compostela**. This afternoon, we visit the **Tomb of St. James** and the **Pilgrim Office** to collect our **Compostelanas** (certificate of completion of the **Camino de Santiago**). Time permitting, there will be some free time to explore on our own. Dinner and overnight **Santiago de Compostela**. **BD**



Day 10, Tues. – We are free to explore this morning prior to joining together to attend the **Pilgrims Mass** at the **Cathedral**. This afternoon, we travel to **Finisterre**, end of the world, as it was known in centuries past. We celebrate the Lords Supper on the beach, and then walk the last couple of kilometers that takes us to the lighthouse. It is here, after walking a further 4 days from **Santiago de Compostela**, that many pilgrims end their journey. We enjoy the sunset before returning to **Santiago** for overnight. **BL**

Day 11, Wednesday, November 6, 2019 – We have an early morning departure for **Santiago de Compostela Airport** where we board our **Iberia Airlines** flight to **Madrid**. We transfer to our **Iberia Airlines** flight to **Chicago O'Hare** and transfer to our **American Airlines** flight back to the **Denver, CO Airport**. **B**

AIR TRANSPORTATION: Round trip economy airline reservations on regularly scheduled airlines. Airline taxes are NOT included and will be determined 60 to 90 days prior to ticketing. You will be invoiced for these taxes.

HOTELS: Rooms with private bath/shower based on double occupancy (two persons sharing). Hotel rating - Deluxe, First Class, Superior Tourist or Tourist are used unless others specified by leader (hotel category is chosen by the group leader). Guest Houses, Retreat Centers & Bed and Breakfasts may have communal rooming arrangements and facilities. Single room accommodation is subject to a surcharge. Hotels are subject to change due to unforeseen circumstances.

SIGHTSEEING: As indicated in the itinerary, with fully licensed English speaking guides unless otherwise determined by the leader; entrance fees as indicated are included.

DEPOSITS AND PAYMENT: Deposits are required at time of registration and balance is due 90 days prior to departure or as listed on the brochure.

CANCELLATIONS: Must be made in writing. Cancellation penalties are determined by the penalties imposed upon Worldwide by the airline carrier, the ground operator, coach company and hotels. **Cancellation penalties will be listed on your invoice and/or on your itinerary or application. Cancellations will be a specific amount plus any unrecoverable charges imposed by our suppliers. Within 45 days of departure, NO REFUNDS unless a date prior to 45 days before departure is listed on your invoice, application and/or itinerary.**

INSURANCE: Worldwide Pilgrimage Ministries acts only as an agent for suppliers and is not responsible for any theft, damage, loss of luggage or illness. The forms for all types of insurance coverage are offered to all registrants prior to departure.

UNUSED TOUR ARRANGEMENTS: are refundable only when agreed to by hotel, coach company or other providers.

BAGGAGE: Since all major airlines are constantly changing their rules regarding checked and hand luggage, we at WWPM suggest that you check with each carrier personally to be sure you are getting the most up to date information. Some airlines even have different rules based on your departure point. Excess baggage charges are very expensive so be sure to weigh and measure your luggage to avoid a big surprise at the check in counter.

NOT INCLUDED: Passport, visa fees, excess baggage charges, baggage or personal insurance, inoculations, laundry, telephone charges, mineral water, food and beverage other than those provided on regular menus as provided by WWPM.
